AGENDA: The Yorktown Civic Association has voted to designate a proposed Yorktown Blvd median and pedestrian safety project as its first priority project for the Spring 2011 Funding Round.

This meeting is being held to share the County’s proposed design. Design includes a new raised median from Little Falls Rd to 28th St N and pedestrian improvements at the Yorktown Blvd and George Mason Drive intersection, including curb extensions, new curb ramps, and a new crosswalk.

Following this meeting, the County will conduct a formal petitioning effort to determine if there is sufficient support (60% of impacted linear frontage) to pursue County funding in the Spring 2011 Neighborhood Conservation Funding Round.
