

Memorandum of Understanding
Between Arlington County and Arlington Public Schools
Regarding the Yorktown High School and Greenbrier Park Projects

April 24, 2003

Arlington County and Arlington Public Schools have both identified a need for capital projects to take place at Yorktown High School and Greenbrier Park. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to set forth the County Manager's ("Manager") and Superintendent of School's ("Superintendent") current understandings and intentions as to how they will proceed with recommendations for those projects for their mutual benefit. Any funding obligations in this agreement shall be subject to appropriation by the appropriate body.

In summary of the Yorktown (Phase I and Phase II) and Greenbrier Park Projects, the following is agreed:

- By approval of the Yorktown master plan, the School Board has granted to the County the right to use land on the Yorktown site near the existing parking and cafeteria off North 28th Street for Greenbrier parking as shown in the master plan document. The exact amount and layout of the County parking will be determined during the Yorktown High School Phase II renewal and Greenbrier Park design processes.
- By approval of the Greenbrier Park master plan, the County Board has granted to the School Board the right to use the land near the existing tennis courts as shown in the Yorktown Master Plan.

The undersigned enter into this Memorandum of Understanding as an expression of their current intent to proceed with the Yorktown High School/Greenbrier Park project as set forth above.
