Where: Yorktown High School Cafeteria

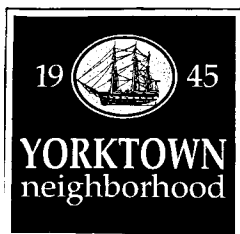
School Board members are holding this meeting to seek comment from the community on a major renovation recently approved by voters for Yorktown High School. The School Board is scheduled to vote on the design for the new building on February 1, 2007, so it is extremely important for nearby residents to come to this meeting to review the building plans. Members of the public will be given an opportunity to ask questions and to comment on the design being proposed to the Board.

While the Yorktown Civic Association (YCA) supports the need to renovate the high school, YCA is opposing the design being presented to the School Board because it does not sufficiently address the serious problem of on-street parking that exists near the school and Greenbrier Park fields. The civic association needs your help in seeking modifications to the design.
